


# A parent's guide to accessing Purple Mash.


1. Open up your web browser on either a computer or tablet and type

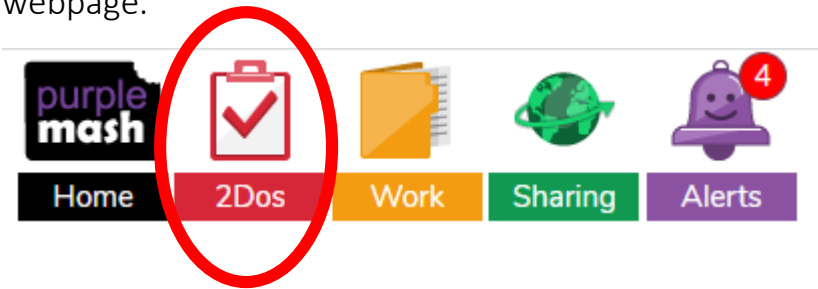
2. Then insert your child's username and password. Click 'Log In'.
3. You will be directed to your child's home screen.



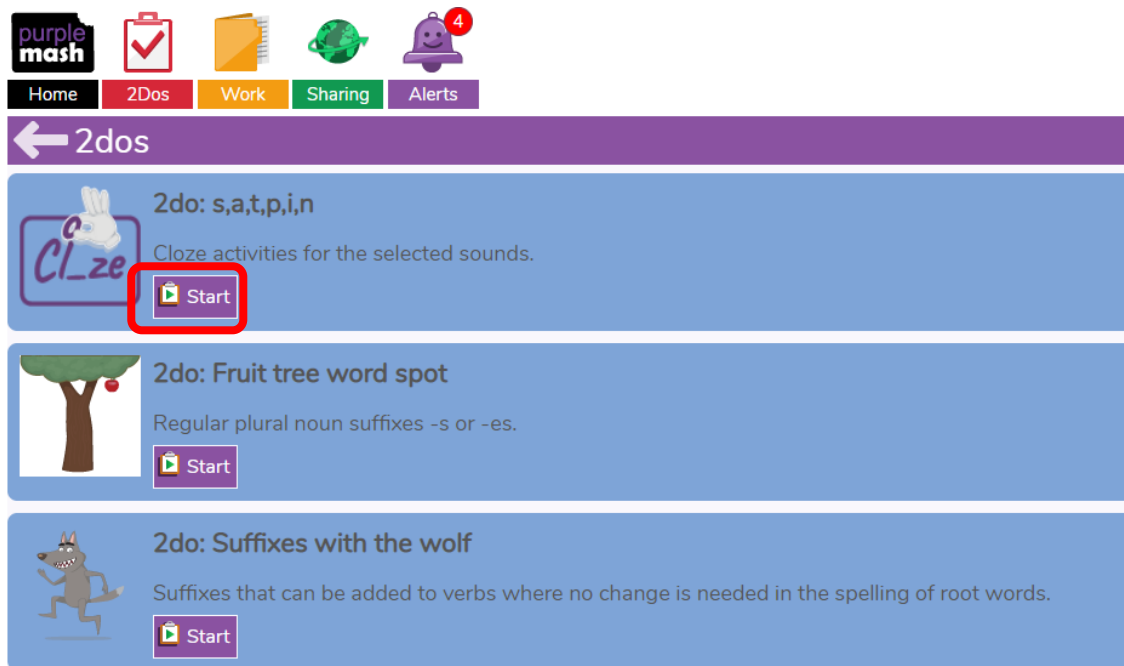

You will then see all the activities set by the teacher and they can press 'start' to begin.

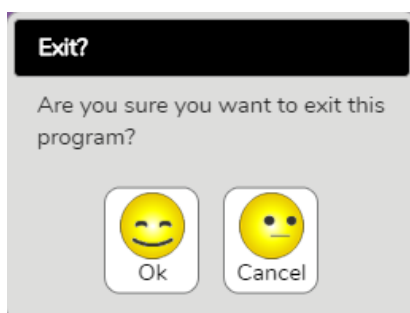


Then select play and allow your child to do the activity.
